RECYCLING AND REPURPOSING

We repurpose <u>clean</u> 100% cotton T-Shirts and cut them from the bottom to just under the arm. We then braid them into jumpropes for distribution in shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child, a ministry of Samaritan's Purse.

T-shirts can be donated at The Worship Place, the Sun City Campus, 811 Sun City Blvd. There is a bin in the Welcome Center of the Church and donations of clean t-shirts can be made when the church is open, normally weekdays 9:00 – 4:00 and on Sundays during church services.
